RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE MODES OF DISPOSITION OF SEIZED/FORFEITED ARTICLES IN LINE WITH SECTIONS 130, 131, AND 225 OF THE NATIONAL INTERNAL REVENUE CODE (NIRC) OF 1997, AS AMENDED

The following are the modes of disposition of seized/forfeited articles:

Mode of Disposition	Definition	Article Subject of Disposition	Requirements
Public Auction	Mode of sale in which seized articles are being sold to multiple buyers thru competitive bidding	Seized articles prejudicial to the enforcement of the law and other regulated articles	None
Negotiated or Private Sale	Mode of sale in which seized articles that remain unsold after the conduct of two (2) failed public auctions are being sold	Seized articles not suitable for official use or donation	 a. Conduct of two (2) failed public auctions; and b. Prior approval of Secretary of Finance; Exception: In the case of <i>personal properties</i>, the abovementioned two (2) requirements may be dispensed with.
